Eligibility

Skills First

Australian citizen or permanent resident or a New Zealand citizen is eligible to do a Skills First Funded course in Victoria, if you met the following criteria.

- You are under 20 (regardless of any other qualifications); or
- You are 20 or older and enrolling in a course that is a higher qualification than you've previously attained.

JobTrainer – **LIMITED PLACES AVAILABLE**

As part of its Economic Response to COVID-19, the Australian Government is providing free or low-fee training courses across the nation through its \$1 billion JobTrainer Fund.

You may be able to study a free or low-fee course through JobTrainer if you are:

- 17 to 24 years old when the course starts; or
- a job seeker of any age.

You must not have commenced a full qualification under JobTrainer before.
