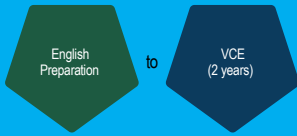

- You can study High School Preparation English with us prior to course commencement of Year 11.



Requirements to pass VCE

Satisfactory completion of 16 units which include:

- Three units from the English group, with at least 2 Units at Unit 3 or 4 level;
- Three sequences of Units 3 and 4 studies other than English.
